





Spiritual Life - Withcott Church of Christ

The Shrine.

I recently returned from a trip to Melbourne. I did lots of touristy things; one being a visit to the Shrine of Remembrance. This was amazing and very emotional. The Shrine was built from 1927 to 1934, to honour the men and women of Victoria who served in WW1, but now is a memorial to all Australians who have served in any war and for those who laboured in support of national defence in wartime. The competition for its design was 'won' by 2 local returned-soldier architects, Philip Hudson and James Wardrop; who better to plan this memorial than men who have served!

What moved me the most was the special memorial inside the main dome. It's set down into the floor about 30cms, so when people come to look at it, their heads are naturally bowed. It reads, "GREATER LOVE HATH NO MAN";

these words are taken from the Bible in **John 15:13**. Those words on the shrine are focusing on lives lost in the wars, but I find it wonderful how God's words are there for everyone, yet there would be many who gaze here and don't know **The ONE Man** who gave His life for **ALL** mankind. It brought me to tears as I stood there, head bowed in reverent silence and gratitude. If that wasn't enough, there was more to amaze!

Leading up to construction in 1927, the architects along with scientists designed a special feature to this magnificent build-

ing. There is a metal plate on the eastern side of the Shrine wall that is removed only once a year allowing sunlight to shine through a cavity into the great room where the memorial is. At 11am on the 11th day of the 11th month, that shaft of sunlight precisely strikes the word LOVE and for

11 minutes moves across that word until it disappears onto the floor! So inspiring!

For those who love Jesus, there are Biblical parallels here. The words from the Bible in John 15:13

- "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends" are all about Jesus who gave His life for our lives.

The shaft of sunlight shining down right on LOVE – made me think of the star of Bethlehem shining down to where the King was born, born through LOVE to give His life for us. John 3:16 – "For God so loved the world that He gave His One and Only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."

'Lest We Forget' the many who sacrificed their lives for us so we can live in this great country, but more importantly, 'Lest We Forget' what Jesus did. Think about it ... God didn't merely like the world, but He loved the world. He loved us so much that He created us, made a way for us, and desired a forever relationship with us.

Because of God's immense love for the world, He gave His one and only Son, because it's only through His death that we can have life.

Believing in Jesus means we choose to trust Him as Saviour and Master of our lives. We cannot earn our salvation, but we can trust The One who saves us. God created us for eternity, but He also gave us the ability to choose Him.

Eternity isn't for the distant future...it's already in motion right now!
